We are thrilled to have completed one re-installation and one brand new installation already in 2019 in two different regions in Guatemala. It is a blessing to reaffirm our commitment to existing partners and connect with new ones in the first weeks of this year.

Our staff have already conducted one operator training as part of our Operator Certification program for the Sololá area cluster. This serves as part of our commitment to support our system partners and promote the long-term sustainability and effectiveness of our systems. In the next 2 months we will have completed 3 more installations - 2 in Guatemala and 1 in Cuba. We are eager to continue the work that God has laid before us and we ask for your prayers as we do so.

In December, four of our board members returned to Cuba to check in on our two LWWM systems there and survey a potential new installation site. It was a blessing to reunite with Pastor Daniel of

The latest of the food distributions was just before Christmas, through My Father's House (Carlos and Heidi Fernandez) to three communities impacted by the volcano. The first plan of action is an installation in Jatibonico (east of Santa Clara) at the Iglesia de Dios Monte de Oración. We are sending a small team there in late March to install the 3rd LWWM system there. We hope there may be more installations next winter.
