3rd Hospital Installation

In October, the last of three LWWM systems was installed at the COVID-19 temporary hospital in the district of Escuintla. This was an entirely new facility with a new well and our staff worked with on-site staff to construct the system and train the hospital personnel who would operate the system to provide the staff and patients with clean water - an essential always but particularly now in this current global pandemic.
