Living Water World Missions has experienced a busy spring and summer!

- April – Ensenada, Mexico (installation)

In addition, we have hired a second employee in Guatemala, Cesia Morales de Palomo, who will oversee in-country logistics, planning, and translation. Cesia will also assist us in health and hygiene education. In July we signed a memorandum of understanding with Compassion International to install up to 73 clean water systems in the next three years. Our efforts will be aimed, Lord willing, at churches with Compassion programs in the northwest highlands of Guatemala. We certainly will need a number of people to accompany us if we are to fulfill the mission to which we believe God has called us.
