# Thank you for your support!



We have been blessed by many opportunities to grow this ministry in the last few months. One of the greatest blessings has been the opportunity to teach our Gospel-focused hygiene education to children at public schools in Guatemala twice and we are planning the same for our upcoming June installation. The photo here shows the children at a public school in Escuiopulas (March) showing their gratitude for the instruction and clean water received.



This spring we have been able to install FOUR water systems thanks to your support! Three were installed in Guatemala and one in Cuba. As of the beginning of May, these four systems had already produced over 6500 gallons of clean water. Total water production for all of LWWM systems in Guatemala and Cuba to over 14.5 million gallons of CLEAN water.



In March beginning with the installation in Jatibonico, Cuba and continuing for the following three weeks in Guatemala, our staff trained this smiling Cuban, Sergio (above), as system technician and installation coordinator. He has returned to Cuba well equipped to support the systems we have there and prepare future sites for new installations in that country. This training has been about two years in the making and we thank God for His faithfulness. In Guatemala, our staff have also been training educators who can assist with installations and with follow-up education in their areas. Here are two sisters and teachers,

### Operator Training Clusters

Each month of 2019 so far our staff have conducted Operator's workshops in regional clusters to further the training of system operators in those areas. This spring they have completed workshops in Huehuetenango, Suchitepequez, and San Marcos areas of Guatemala.
