

## MAKING PROGRESS

- We now have 36 systems in Guatemala that have produced over 2.25 million gallons of clean water.
- We now have four employees in Guatemala to help maintain existing systems, to survey and prepare for future installations, to coordinate trips, and to help lead installations and education alongside our North American team members and local Guatemalans at each site.
- For the 4th year, members of our board have helped set up and teach at Clean Water University at Calvin Crest above Oakhurst in June.
- This July, the Board of Living Water World Missions hired former board member, Melody Downie-Dack as our new administrative assistant. She will be handling team applications and communication among other duties.
