Over seven million gallons produced in Guatemala!

With 57 systems now in Guatemala, a total of just over 7 million gallons of clean water have been produced in that country. Thank you to all of you who support this ministry - through prayer, financial support, team member participation, and promotion. We are pleased to share with you a quarterly update of what the Lord is doing through Living Water World Missions in Guatemala and beyond! This year so far we have had 67 volunteer team members, including 27 first timers! These volunteers came from 13 different states and the youngest was nine years old!

Guatemala Warehouse

Supporting our site partners

We now have a small warehouse in Guatemala to store system parts and other supplies for installation and for system repairs. This warehouse allows our staff in Guatemala to keep the required materials on hand to ensure the long term success of systems installed by LWWM.

Upon installation, every system includes a three year covenant with LWWM during which we provide technical support and replacement parts at no cost. After three years, the site partners may chose to continue in partnership with a maintenance agreement in which we provide technical support and replacement parts at cost. Most of our site partners chose to sign maintenance agreements after the initial three years so we have a lot of systems to support.



Summer Installations



There were some exciting installations and other projects this summer. In June our team experienced a violent earthquake in Guatemala and thanks be to God that no one on the team or at the installation site was harmed despite the close proximity of the epicenter. In July we had a team from the Lighthouse youth ministries of Santa Ynez Valley Presbyterian Church (see photo). In August we had a large team from five states including three generations of one family. Also in August we sent four board members to provide technical support to a system we installed in Haiti at an orphanage in 2012. Our [2018 installation dates](#) have been decided for Guatemala.
