In June, board members and staff traveled to the eastern Jutiapa area for seven follow-up visits. They met with Church leaders and toured previously installed systems. It was a blessing to see that many system operators are doing well. Not only are they blessing their communities with clean and affordable drinking water, but many have been able to use the systems as a tool to bring others closer to the Lord.











In July, our **100th system** was installed at the Iglesia de Dios Evangelio Completo Central in San Cristóbal, Alta Verapaz, Guatemala. A beautifully built system room awaited the team along with many willing helping hands. It was a successful installation week that included the new Evangelism training to the women within the church leadership, who then carried on their training to women within their community to share the word of the Lord with. A beautiful dedication followed completion of the system. All who attended were invited to tour the newly installed water system.

Our August installation team was in Retalhuleu, Guatemala at the Iglesia Jesucristo es el Rey. Another amazing install filled with gratitude throughout the week by church leaders and volunteers. The system was installed, pressure tested and completed successfully with the training and testing of system operators. This church is part of a multi-partner church system with three other churches who work together to provide for those in need. Exciting to think of the good the system will be doing to aid in their outreach work.


